Delta customers flying from CVG this spring will soon have more choices for nonstop international flights. New nonstop service to Cabo San Lucas begins February 18th. Daily nonstop flights to Amsterdam and Rome return March 1st. Air France will resume a daily nonstop flight to Paris on May 8th, and Delta's nonstop service to Cancun will return to CVG in June. These flights are part of Delta's ongoing transformation plan, which includes increased international service.
